40 "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

Dear Church family,

Some may not understand why I suddenly took off this past Sunday to help on the border of Ukraine. It had been brewing in my heart all week and out of the blue, before preaching at Sandcross Church, I received a message from a pastor friend asking me to help him bring his family home from the conflict in Ukraine. They had travelled for 4 days, having stood for 11 hours, toe to toe, on a train, with bombs sounding around them.

There are several things I have learned following my trip which I will share with you here: 1. Be willing to be interruptible like Jesus – sometimes there are events that side line our immediate ministry. 2. Be willing for your plans to go out the window – from the minute we landed in Slovakia, the plans changed. We found out that we would now need to drive 9 hours to Poland! Yet God ensured our success! 3. Expect a miracle – Our Sheik felt called by the lord to join me – without his driving, the mission would have failed. My driving licence had expired and with us needing to enter Poland, we needed a driver, God knew all along what we needed! 4. Above all else, have compassion for our fellow humans – I cannot tell you how there was a sense of what the world wars felt like, seeing refugees filling up hotels, etc.

A time may be upon us when the love of people may be more important than our plans, goals, success and livelihood. A time is upon us, whereby we need to return to God. The world is a volatile place and we need to love God, love one another and pray for revival! FEAR NOT, TRUST IN GOD!
